We wish it was simpler for our pet owners to identify foods that made sense for their pets. It shouldn't be such a game and we recognize that the choices out there are literally endless. Even celebrities have started endorsing pet foods, which hurts a little, because we are pretty sure we know more about pet nutrition than they do!!
