Let's talk about Ticks!

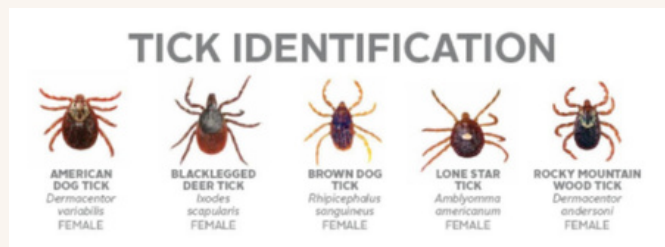


Have you been enjoying the nice weather we have been having?

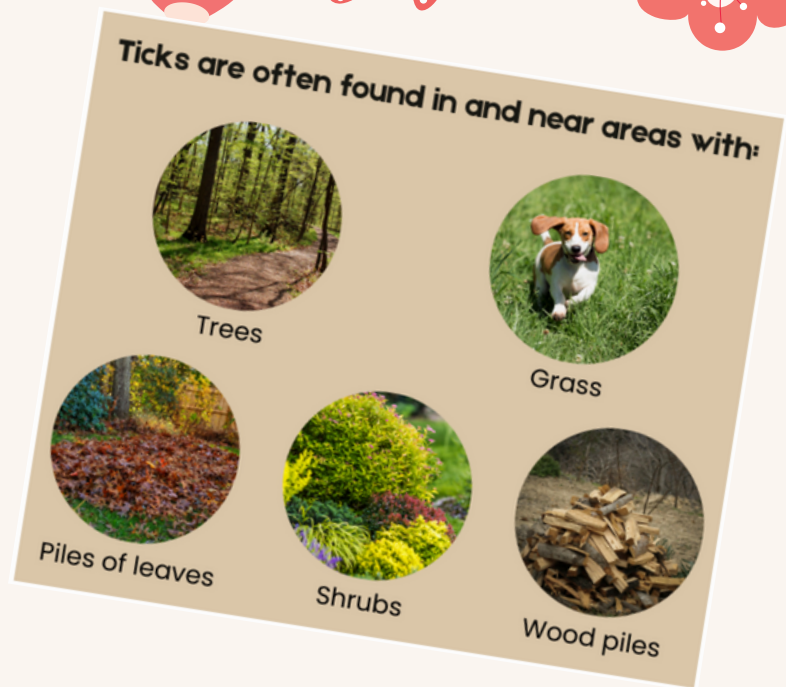
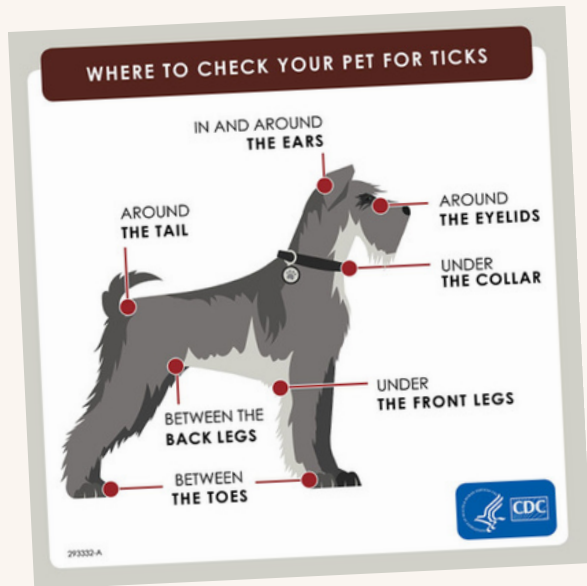
The ticks have been as well!

There are several different tick species in this area.

The most common ones are:



It is very important that you check both yourself and your pets for ticks whenever you come in from spending any amount of time outside!



Have you started your pet on Flea and Tick Prevention?

Ticks can be active at any time when it's over 4°C. They are most active in the spring and fall, but can be active anytime. We recommend year-round flea and tick prevention. Our team is here to help you decide which prevention product is best for your furry family member. Give us a call today!

Have you been asked if you would like to run a 4Dx this year?

A 4Dx is a blood test that screens for tick-borne diseases such as Lyme disease, Anaplasmosis, and Ehrlichia, as well as Heartworm. We recommend screening your pets once yearly, or after exposure to any tick bites. We also recommend to test for Heartworm before starting heartworm prevention each year.
